## **150 YEARS OF HISTORY:**

# METROLOGY IS PAVING THE WAY FOR TOMORROW AT CIM2025

The International Metrology Congress (CIM) took place from **March 11 to 14**, 2025 at **Eurexpo** Lyon (France), hosted by **Global Industrie**, the largest industrial trade show in France.

## A confirmed success for the 22nd edition of CIM

The 2025 International Metrology Congress, organized by the CFM (Collège Français de Métrologie), reinforced its position as a key event for the measurement and metrology sector and continues to grow on the international stage.

Key figures:

- **\* 500 participants** from **40 different countries** gathered to discuss major metrology challenges.
- 180 oral and poster presentations covering key topics such as measurement digitalization, AI applied to metrology and sustainability.
- ✓ 18 oral sessions, 5 round tables and 2 poster sessions encouraging knowledge sharing and technical exchanges.
- 2 new highlights on the program: the QI-Digital workshop and a short course on ISO/IEC 17025.
- The Metrology Village by CFM spanned 1,000 sqm, hosting 60 exhibitors at the heart of the Measurement, Control, Vision and Instrumentation area.
- 📌 A magical **Gala Event** held at Cirque Imagine.

### 2025, a year marked by a historic milestone

This year marks the **150th anniversary of the Metre Convention**: a century and a half of international collaboration in metrology and a testament to the profound impact of measurement on the past, present and future. The anniversary was commemorated at CIM2025 with a conference address by Martin Milton, Director of the BIPM and

President of CIM2025: "Celebrating 150 Years of the Metre Convention, measurements for all times, for all peoples."

## **Global Industrie and CIM: a perfect match**

Global Industrie, France's premier industrial gathering, brought together more than **2,500 exhibitors** and welcomed **45,000 visitors** over four days (a 20% increase compared to 2023).

During the CIM opening ceremony, key figures took the stage, including **Thomas Courbe** – Director General of the Directorate General for Enterprises, **Laurent Labatut** – CEO at Trescal, **Cosimi Corleto** – President of the CFM and CEO of STIL Marposs, **Martin Milton** – Director of the BIPM and **Julie Voyer** – Director of Global Industrie. Each emphasized the vital collaboration between metrology and industry.

CIM attendees included representatives from both the institutional world (National Metrology Institutes and research laboratories) and the industrial sector, who came to stay informed, connect with fellow experts and share best practices in measurement and metrology. Many of these industrial players were also exhibitors in the **Metrology Village by CFM**.

Thanks to this diverse audience (metrologists, engineers, R&D professionals...), the CIM fosters dialogue between the scientific and industrial communities, creating fertile ground for new innovation dynamics to emerge.
