*The International Metrology Congress (CIM) returns for its 22nd edition, scheduled from **11 - 14 March 2025**, at **Eurexpo Lyon (France)**. This must-attend event in the **measurement and metrology sector** highlights best industrial practices as well as applied research on the reliability of measurement data. Organized by the CFM (Collège Français de Métrologie), the CIM attracts nearly **650 participants from 45 different countries** each year. The Congress renews its partnership with **Global Industrie**, the largest industrial exhibition in France, thus consolidating its position as a **key event** for the sector.*

Metrology plays a crucial role in addressing today's environmental and digital challenges. This year, the emphasis will be on **how metrology can support sustainability** through numerous oral and poster presentations, as well as the key plenary session during the Congress. During **four days**, participants will have the opportunity to explore all the major topics related to international metrology issues.

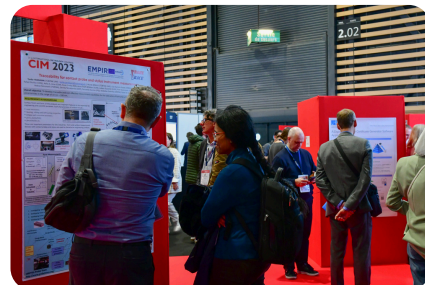
